

PURPOSE/MISSION

Funds for this scholarship will come from a variety of programs, private industries, organizations, and private donations.

The scholarship program will award scholarships annually to eligible students. The scholarship recipient should be a student actively engaged in community service and demonstrating leadership skills critical to the development of a civil society.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating high school student with the intent of entering college for the first time or be currently enrolled in an accredited college, university or trade school.
- 2. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale.
- 3. Applicant must demonstrate community service as well as campus leadership.

CRITERIA

The criteria used to select the finalists will include the following:

- Academic record and class rank Applicant is required to submit an official transcript, sealed. An official transcript may be sent electronically from the school to the email address: mvh.scholarship.fund@gmail.com.
- Record of performance in scholastic and extracurricular activities both in school and in the community.
- Quality and originality of essay.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

All applications must be <u>POSTMARKED</u> (It's important that your mail gets postmarked to verify the date it was sent.) on or before June 30, of current year to:

- Application and all supporting documents must be mailed in a 9x12 envelope.
- No faxed or scanned documents will be accepted.
- All scholarships awarded will be made payable to selected University, College or Trade School.
- Recipients of scholarship must notify the Myrtle V. Hunter OES
 Scholarship Program of his/her acceptance within one (1) week following
 notification award. Failure to do so will result in withdrawal of the award
 and subsequent selection of an alternate.
- It is the responsibility of the applicant to notify the Director of any change in mailing address, email, or phone number.
- Only the Scholarship Committee and/or RoseMary Grand Chapter's Board of Directors will have access to applicant's information. All information remains confidential.

To apply, students must submit a single packet to include the following:

- A completed application (typed or written legibly)
- Official transcript, sealed
- Essay Question 1 (250 words)
- Essay Question 2 (250 words)
- Essay Question 3 (250 words)
